How can you help

We are in need of volunteers who, if available, with only a 24 hour notice (or in some cases less notice), can help staff and operate the Extreme Weather Conditions Shelter.

Volunteer Opportunities

- Staff a volunteer shift. (Sign In, Evenings, Overnight, Mornings)
- Prepare and serve dinner or breakfast.
- Help transport guests in the evening and/or the morning.
- Clean and sanitize in the morning.
